Mike Page: Technical Director for the Westside Breakers Soccer Club

Mike is currently the Technical Director for the Westside Breakers Soccer Club where he is responsible for managing the coaching staff and the development of the players. The Breakers currently have 13 girls teams, ages U10 to U19. Prior to coming to the Breakers, Mike held various positions with the Los Angeles Galaxy and Major League Soccer, including serving as the league's Director of Player Administration from 1995-1997. Mike has coached various teams in different clubs on the Westside for over 15 years. He played soccer and graduated from Santa Monica High School in 1980 and then played collegiately at Cal State Los Angeles. After graduating, Mike played professionally for the California Kickers of the Western Soccer League from 1986-1989. Mike holds a US Soccer Federation "A" coaching license

Richard Simms: Head Coach *Westside Breakers '88, '90 & '93 White*

Richard is a Nationally licensed USSF coach, he's been a head coach for the Westside Breakers Soccer Club for the past five seasons and has been coaching competitive soccer for the past seven. Richard has coached all levels of soccer, starting out coaching in the San Fernando Valley Private School League with 4th graders, then a season with Westmark School's Boy's Varsity soccer team. Richard has also coached the Immaculate Heart High School Girl's Varsity team and is currently Head of Girl's Soccer at Crossroads School in Santa Monica, heading into his third year in charge of the program. For the Breakers Richard has coached in the illustrious Coast Soccer League and has compiled a record of 68 wins, 24 losses and 12 ties. In addition to this remarkable record he has also won 7 Flight I tournaments and has reached at least the semi-final of 16 of the 24 tournaments in which he has coached. Richard's philosophy in coaching girls soccer is to connect with players mentally and allow players creative freedom. All of his teams are encouraged to pass the ball and play a flowing style of soccer which emphasizes possession, determination and intelligence.

Brain Miller is the Technical Director for Brit-West Soccer which organizes local camps in Beverly Hills, Culver City, Manhattan Beach, Santa Monica, and Westchester.
